1980: Students & faculty at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary publish the first *Baptist Peacemaker*.

1984: BPFNA is founded at Deer Park Baptist Church in Louisville, Ky.



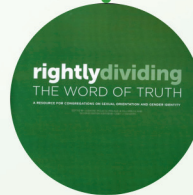
1990: Peacemakers take a friendship tour to the U.S.S.R.
